Scottish FA Quality Mark Review Success

The club has reached another milestone, as the first in the Central Region to achieve the Scottish FA Quality Mark "Community Level" Award back in 2008, we are now the first to be subject to the required 3 year review process which was recently carried out, this resulting in the club successfully retaining its status for a further 3 years.

The Quality Mark award is awarded to clubs who are able to demonstrate that it meets the necessary criteria as to a playing & coaching programme, coach development, child protection, sports equity and ethics, and club management. Over and above this a key objective of the Community Award is to ensure that participants are encouraged to stay with a Club and continue to play, train and compete at their chosen level whilst developing a sense of Community belonging. Clubs also require to have a minimum of eight teams representing children, youths, adults and girls/women. With 17 sections and 20+ teams in all 330 players we are the only club in the area able to offer the full male pathway and the only club offering girls football. The Club is also required to seek and identify talent, develop it, and produce young players capable of performing at their maximum level. Its an exciting time for the club and on completion of our new 3g hub this will provide a home base allowing the organisation to truly come together as a community club; increasing the current membership and enabling the club to maximise its resources in doing so take the club to a new level.
