## Central's First SFA QM Development Award



Many of you will be aware via the local press that the club was credited by the SFA Central Region Committee as being the first recipients of the SFA Development Quality Mark. To achieve this level a club must have a minimum of 4 teams at different age groups and ensure that they have a coach at each team with a level 3 coaching qualification, other criteria set for this level the club also must have specialists appointed such as a Goalkeeping coach, Welfare

Officer and Coach Co-ordinator and be able to demonstrate planning over a 2 year period. Presenting the award to Stewart McKenzie, chairperson, SFA Regional Manager Andy Gilchrist commented "We are delighted to announce the first Development Quality Mark Club in the region and particularly pleased that it is Cumbernauld Colts. I have been impressed with the enthusiasm shown by all connected with the club in their efforts to gain this award, which has been a huge challenge for a club that has provision for under 8s football through to under 19s." There was also a further boost to the club in recognition of achieving the Quality Mark, with our U19 team receiving new strips courtesy of the Frankie and Benny's restaurant in Coatbridge.
