## Coach Development—Investing in the Future

Over the coming months a number of coaches from various sections will undertake SFA Coaching Courses, as a minimum all our sections require to have at least one Level 3 coach, in many cases we have 2 or 3. We are also investing in the future and are supporting two of our U21 players; Johnny Hamilton and Danny Cahill and Girls Academy Assistant Coach Beth Mchugh through the various levels allowing them to help within the children and youth sections. We will also have two coaches undertake the SFA Disabilities course later in the year and another two attend the Children's Level 4 course.
