## Club on the Brink of New Home

Our aspirations to have our own home and realise the real benefits of being a community club have taken a huge step forward with two significant funding awards.

Many of you will be aware we have been seeking our own home for many years with little to no progress, last year we established a small committee sub group with a remit to actively peruse this agenda and following discussions with

NLC we produced a business case at their request to support the development of a state of the art 3G pitch and changing accommodation, this was well received by NLC and we began considering potential sites and more importantly where the substantial funding could be sourced from.

The Environmental Key Fund was identified as a potential funding source and to underpin this application we commissioned a consultant to carry-out a needs assessment, this application was subsequently successful and we were awarded a terrific

£150,000 back on November, however this fund would only be allocated on confirmation of the other match funding required to deliver the total project.



As an SFA Quality Mark "Community Award" club our business case was also shared with the Scottish FA to seek

their support of our community project, subsequently this was considered for support via the Scottish Governments **CashBack for Communities** programme, this programme has been incredibly successful in using money seized from the proceeds of crime to fund projects in every part of Scotland. We are delighted to be in a position to advise you that we have been awarded a fantastic £400,000, which takes us very close to the funding we require to deliver the project.

We now hope to confirm the preferred site in the very near future to allow us to kick start the project, I am sure you all agree this is fantastic news and will provide a platform for the club move to a new level.
